SIGN LOCATION: (Address and Method of Attachment)

Signs are prohibited from being placed in any local, state, or federal right-of-way or in a location that would obstruct the view of any traffic sign or signal, or obstruct the sight distance triangle at any street intersection. Signs shall not be constructed of, illuminated by, or operated by electrical, electronic, or mechanical parts. Height of the sign shall not extend in height above the roofline or if attached to a permanent sign then exceed the height requirements of the type of freestanding sign. Sign shall only be located on the premise that it advertises.

DESCRIPTION OF SIGN: (Size and Height) _____

White House Zoning Ordinance, Section 4.070 Standards for Signs, Item I:

Temporary Event and Advertising Signs- Any business, individual, or organization may display one (1) banner sign per lot. In the case of multiple tenants per lot than no more than two (2) signs will be permitted at any one time. The signs must be separated by at least twenty-five (25) feet. The sign or signs can be placed a maximum of four (4) times a year not exceeding twenty-eight (28) days in any calendar year, with twenty-one (21) days between permits. A sign permit shall be obtained each time a banner is placed on site. A temporary banner sign shall not exceed twenty (20) square feet in area. The location and height of banner signs shall be in accordance with the White House Zoning Ordinance. Temporary Event and Advertising Signs pursuant to this section shall be required to have a permit issued without fee from the Planning and Codes Department.

All provisions of the laws and ordinances governing signs will be compiled with, whether or not it is specified herein. Granting of this permit does not presume to give authority to violate or cancel the provisions of any other federal, state, or local law regulating signs.

Violation of the provisions of the sign ordinance or this document shall deem the sign an illegal sign. The zoning administrator, building inspector, or other person designated to enforce this ordinance may remove or order the removal of any sign not in conformance with the provision of this ordinance, at the expense of the sign owner or lessor.
